# FEEDBACK REPORT

## REPORT

We were successful in getting hold of your attorney and track all the relevant details on your claim as well as the full case history to date. A summary of the information is provided on page 1 for your record and reference. More detailed information, including supporting documents traced are attached to this report for your record and reference.

The next step for your claim is to perform medical expert reports, which are required before a settlement can be discussed with RAF. It is unclear why this has been stalled.

## RECOMMENDATION

The good news is that your claim is still valid and underway, and at a cursory glance a valid claim appears to be in order. Your attorney firm are fully licensed to practice and no concerns have been identified. Summons has been issued against RAF on your case, which means that prescription has been interrupted and your claim cannot expire until the matter is fully resolved.

The next important step is to have medical expert reports performed, as this will form the basis for your claim against RAF, and any discussions of settlement are highly unlikely without these reports complete.

The next steps are for you to contact your attorney and enquire about when medical assessments will be performed. This can take some time to arrange so you may need to be patient. We recommend following up telephonically or by email every second week until this is resolved. Please keep records of all your communication.

If this is not resolved after a few months you may need to seek resolution by approaching another law firm to take over your file. Note: this must be done in consultation with your existing attorneys who will need to hand over the files, and also settle the existing fees accumulated to date.
